

SHEPHERDS AND SHEEP IN WOOL LEAD

Entry fee: \$5.00 per contestant, plus \$5.00 per ewe entered (attach money & commentary to entry form)

The objectives of this contest are to:

- (1) Provide a fashion parade of imaginatively attired youth in wool garments
- (2) Showcase smoothly blocked sheep with long wool
- (3) Give spectators the opportunity to appreciate the wool industry
- (4) Afford youth in Torrance County the chance to compete

Classes

Pre-school (pee-wee) age 5 and under

Junior, age 9-13

Novice, age 6-8

Senior, age 14-20

Rules

1. To be eligible contestants must be residents of Torrance County or attend a Torrance County school.
2. Major articles of clothing must be hand or homemade of at least 60% wool. Non-wool accessories are permissible and do not have to be hand-made, but ready-made wool garments are not permissible. The outfit should be in step with current fashion and compliment the contestant.
3. Clothing construction will be judged only as it affects the final appearance of the garment on the contestant. Garments should fit well and be neatly constructed.
4. The pre-school, novice, and junior division will not be allowed to show a ewe. They will only model their garments.
5. The senior division contestants must show on halter a purebred two tooth yearling ewe only. The contestant need not own the ewe. No ewe may be shown by more than one contestant.
6. The ewe should be attractively fitted and groomed, but not colored or in any way artificially prepared for the show. The ewe should be clean (washing of ewes optional), smoothly blocked in long wool (wool should be at least one-inch-long), in good condition, alert, stylish, and well-balanced.
7. The ewe should respond calmly to the halter and stand quietly when handled by the judge. Ease and calmness in handling the ewe will contribute significantly to good showmanship.
8. Poise, grooming, balance, and attitude of the contestant and ewe will be judged. Hair style, makeup, and accessories should enhance the total appearance.
9. Stall facilities will be provided.
10. Entry forms must include an information and commentary sheet about the contestant and his/her sheep. This information/commentary can include things such as hobbies, where contestant attends school, 4-H/FFA club activities, school activities, etc. This information will assist in the introduction of each contestant and commentary given while he/she is modeling in the contest.
11. Ewes must be on the grounds by 12:00pm, Tuesday, August 6th, 2019, to go through animal check-in procedures, and they will be released immediately after the contest.
12. The superintendent reserves the right to combine classes to best suit the needs of the class.

Judging

Awarding of points will be made on the following standard:

1. The contestant awarded the highest number of total points in each class will be declared the winner.
2. In case of a tie, bonus points will be given for creativity and originality.
3. All entries will receive a ribbon.
4. First Place in each age division will receive an award.

A. Judging the Contestant

1. General Appearance & Fashion Consciousness: Selection & Fit of Outfit, and Personality and Poise.
2. Judging the Overall Picture, Contestant and Ewe: Poise and Behavior, Personality and Attitude, and Overall Effect.

B. Judging the Ewe

1. General Appearance, Ease/Calmness at Halter, Fitting of the Ewe.

The "Overall Winner" will be based on 25% points towards the ewe, and 75% points toward the contestant.

- (3) Afford youth in Torrance County the chance to compete

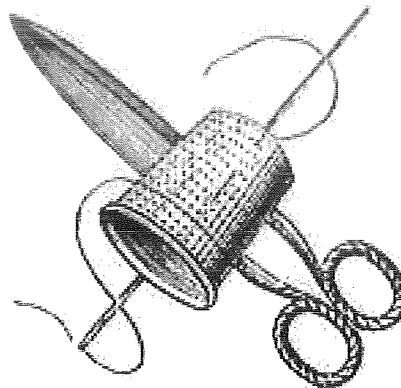
Classes

Pre-school (pee-wee) age 5 and under

General rules for Contest

1. Contestant must be a resident of Torrance County.
2. All items must be clean and in excellent condition.
3. Garment must have been completed within the last year.
4. Fabric or yarn may be 100% or a blend of at least 60% cotton.
5. Rhinestones, fur, sequins, etc. will be accepted as trimming.
6. Lining and trimming of garment should be left to the contestants' discretion (need not be made of cotton)
7. An original design or commercial pattern may be used.
8. This contest is only open to non-professional seamstresses.
